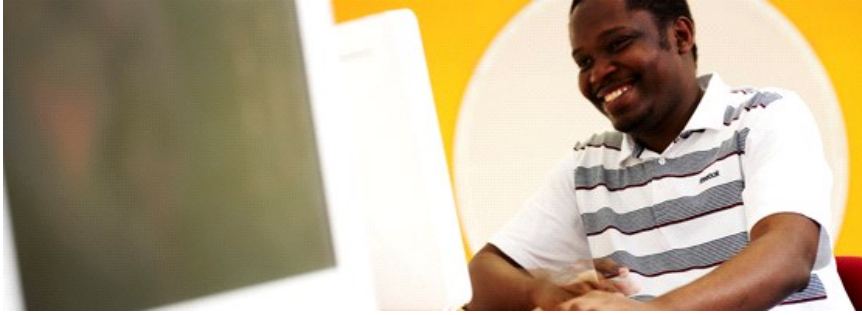


Information for applicants
